EAST LANSING RECIEVES AWARD

The City of East Lansing was recently awarded a 2005 Promoting Active Communities Award by the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and the Michigan Department of Community Health at the annual conference of the Michigan Association of Planning on Mackinac Island, Sept. 16.



The Award recognizes innovative Michigan communities who are making it easier for their citizens to lead a more active lifestyle through supportive programs, public policies and community design. AnnMarie Schneider, Pinecrest Board Member, worked with City Manager Ted Staton to complete the city's application.

The Governor's Council on Physical Fitness coordinates the Promoting Active Communities Award because it directly addresses the need for increased physical activity in Michigan. Bulk Yard Waste

Each fall, the City conducts a bulk yard waste collection for East Lansing. During this collection, no bags, stickers or fees are required; simply rake your loose leaves, grass clippings, and plant material (no brush) between the curb and sidewalk. If there is no curb, rake leaves to within three feet of the road. **Please DO NOT rake leaves into the road as they block storm drains.**

- **WEST SIDE:** From Abbott Road to the west City limits at Coolidge and West Road. Will be collected during the weeks of Oct. 24, Nov. 7 & Nov. 21.

The collection schedule depends on equipment and weather and may be adjusted. Weekly updates will be posted on the city's 24 hour number at 351-4999 and on the website.
